



# AVReporter v4.0 Setup Quick Start Guide



**AVReporter Requirements:** Windows 7 SP1/8/8.1/10, Windows Server 2012/2016  
Microsoft SQL Server 2012, 2014, 2016 (Windows 7 SP1 is not supported by SQL Server 2016), Microsoft®  
.NET framework 4.5.2 or 4.6

Locate **AVREPORTERSETUP\_X64.EXE** and execute it. This file can be in a directory on your PC's hard drive if you opted to download AVReporter from our website.

1. If we do not have the .NET Framework 4.5.2, click on the first icon, which will automatically install it.

2. Click on the SQL Server 2016 Express+ database to install the SQL server and the AVReporter database.

3. Select the desired AVReporter version for the installation. Click „Install AVReporter“ button.

4. Install the WebPublisher by clicking on the „WebPublisher“ button.

**AVReporter First Launch:** To launch the software for the first time, double-click on the AVReporter - Desktop Manager icon on the desktop.
